Local Energy Programs- Include Oregon Energy Programs, Oregon Trail Electric, Low-Income Residential Assistance Program, Project Share, & Helping Hands.

Demand Response- an ADA service for those prevented from using a fixed route by a disability. Demand Response is like Paratransit, except it is open to anyone. The services are similar and are sometimes collectively referred to as Dial-a-Ride. For purposes of this report, we include Dial-a-Ride, Paratransit, and Medical rides in this category.

Fixed Route- A general public accessible service featuring regular published stops and schedules.

Intercity- Routes scheduled with regular frequency to the next (usually larger) community where a better range of mobility options exists. Our services include Enterprise to and from La Grande; La Grande to and from Elgin; and Baker City to and from La Grande.
