#### **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Transports passengers to a variety of locations (usually within the county). Offers assistance to all passengers as they enter and leave the vehicle.

#### SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the supervision of the County Manager and/or Transit Operations Manager.

### SUPERVISION EXERCISED

Generally, there are no supervisory responsibilities with this position.

<u>TYPICAL DUTIES</u> (Any one position may not involve all the duties listed, and many positions will involve duties not listed.)

- 1. Responsible for transporting elderly, persons with disabilities and general public riders.
- 2. Responsible for the safety of persons while they are on the vehicle, and while they are entering or leaving the vehicle.
- 3. Maintain records on the number/type of passengers, miles driven, gas and oil used.
- 4. Assist passengers with their carry-on items on and off the vehicle as needed.
- 5. Responsible for fueling, routine checks, and keeping the vehicle interior clean.
- 6. Other duties as assigned.

## REQUIRED EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS

- ~ High School Graduation or GED certificate. Must have a valid Oregon driver's license, and a safe driving record.
- ~ Must have the ability to work pleasantly and professionally with the public and co-workers and have the ability to follow written and oral instructions.
- ~ Must have reasonable knowledge of vehicle operations; physically able to assist wheelchair

- ~ Ability to lift objects up 50-75 lbs.
