### **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

The Kitchen Assistant assists the Cooks in basic food preparation, washes dishes, pots and pans, cleans equipment, and performs other duties as assigned.

### **SUPERVISION EXERCISED**

Generally, there are no supervisory responsibilities with this position.

## TYPICAL EXAMPLES OF WORK (Any one position will not usually involve all the duties listed, and many positions will involve duties which are not listed.)

- 1. Assists cooks as requested. This will include such items as preparing vegetables, baking, making coffee, preparing salads, preparing meals for home-delivery, and setting tables.
- 2. Washes dishes, pots and pans, and other equipment.
- 3. Washes and mops floors, cleans walls, cupboards, shelves in kitchen, etc.
- 4. Organizes stock, open boxes, etc.
- 5. Issues supplies from stockroom, refrigerators, freezers, and other storage areas.
- 6. Assists in inventory and stock control.
- 7. May transport prepared food to meal sites.
- 8. Assist with catering including prep, set-up, delivery, serving, and clean-up.
- 9. Other duties as assigned.
