Northeast Oregon Regional Food Bank seeks part-time Food Bank Warehouse and Distribution Driver. If you have a desire to serve your community, take hold of this great opportunity. This individual will be delivering produce and other products throughout Community Connection’s four-county service area, as well as setting up the delivery orders, keeping accurate inventory and assisting in warehouse custodial tasks.

This position is part-time at 20-29 hours per week, and a pay range of \$15.02 - \$19.69/hour. Benefits will include paid vacation and sick leave, and eligible for retirement benefits after one year of employment.

Position Duties Include:

- Set up produce delivery orders.
- Arrange drop-off times with local partners. Deliver produce on a specified route throughout the counties of Baker, Grant, Union, and Wallowa.
- Oversee distribution of products to people in need and interact with volunteers who are running distribution of products.
- Monitor temperatures of food that requires time and temperature control, vehicle cooler, and on-site freezers/coolers.
- Receive and safely unload deliveries with forklift if needed.
- Keep accurate inventory records on all received products and products being distributed.
