# **Available Routes?**

Baker NEO Transit, funded by STIF Formula, offers a safe, efficient, and fare-free Deviated Fixed Route service Monday through Friday, 7am to 6pm, and Saturday, 7:45am to 12:45pm. For residents living more than 3/4 of a mile from the fixed route or with mobility challenges, a Demand Response service is available during the weekday hours. STIF funding has also expanded rural Demand Response services, connecting outlying areas to Baker City for shopping and appointments. Additionally, a weekly bus service to Ontario provides access to more amenities. All services are accessible, with wheelchair-friendly buses, bike racks, and service animal accommodations.
